Parent Teacher Interviews 2025

Last term on Thursday, 19th June, Kelvin Road School hosted their Parent Teacher Interviews/ Three Way Conferences.

We are pleased to announce, the below data shows 2025 was stronger than all recent years!



The data shows:

- 79% of all parents booked for an interview. This shows parents have a high level of engagement and interest in their children’s learning. The Year 1-2 classes had a 76% turnout with the Middle School aged pupils having a 71% turnout and the Year 5+ having a 73% turnout.
- 86% of the **bookings** showed up. This is the highest in recent years.
- 73% of the children had Three Way Conferences / Interviews. This is the highest result in recent years and means 400 children were able to talk about their progress with their teacher and family. This is 97 more than our previous best year.
- The most popular time slots were at the beginning of the day.

If you were unable to meet with your child’s teacher, you can still come in, call or email your child’s teacher if you want clarity on progress. If you met the teacher and want to meet again, YOU CAN! It is always important to us that you understand your child’s progress and next steps...you do not have to wait for the official parent / teacher interviews.
