Students:

- Year 4 8 are required to wear masks when indoors;
- It is preferred that students bring their own water bottles;
- Please send your child to school with morning-tea. Lunch will be provided.

Parents / Caregivers:

- Are required to wear a mask when coming onsite;
- Contact tracing is required via scanning the QR code available or filling in the register;
- If your child is sick, please keep them at home. If they present any symptoms at school, they and their siblings will be sent home.
- Online learning will be only available for those required to self-isolate, who are waiting for a test result or who have complex medical needs and therefore cannot attend school.
