#### Attendance

Thank you to all the parents/caregivers who are contacting the school when your child is absent.

Remember you can **text 021 089 17417, phone (09)298 8417 or use the Skool Loop App** to explain the reason as to why your child is absent. If you are unable to contact the school on the day, please write a note for your child to bring to the office on their return date.

Children should only be kept home from school if they are sick. Should your child present themself as sick at school, you will be contacted to collect your child. **School starts at 8.30 am**.

Below are some solutions to common problems we come across.

Problems	Solutions			
Uniform dirty/wet	Send your child to school in mufti and we can provide a uniform for the day which they return before they go home.			
No lunch	Lunches are now provided for every child, every day. They also receive fruit everyday for morning tea.			
No breakfast	We have a breakfast club that runs 5 days a week from 8:00 am - 8.30 am. Everyone is welcome to come along for some weetbix.			
Raining	The school provided raincoats though Kidscan to help children on the way to school Another way to help is to put your child's uniform in a plastic bag in their school bag and v they get to school they can get dry and changed back into their uniform.			
Head Lice and skin infections	If you have given consent our nurses onsite can see and treat your children for free if you have concerns with head lice or skin infections.			

#### **Cost of Living Payment**
