We have also been learning about safety online, focusing on digital citizenship, keeping personal information private and asking for help when we need it. From there, we have been exploring some basic coding concepts, such as learning what a code, event and loop are and how they make computers work. We created short 'codes' of dance moves, looped our codes and changed codes when events happened, just like computers do.
